STATEMENT

My mixed-media sculptural work stems from an innate desire to build three-dimensionally in relation to concepts of nature and the human experience. I transform everyday objects and recycled materials into humorous, organic-looking forms. My large-scale works replicate the closeness of furniture to the body. My muted, neutral color plate allows for more focus on the forms and enigmatic connections to nature and body shapes. I play with the balance between seduction and repulsion by conceptualizing how materials can be objectified and altered through form and surface treatment. My work is awkward, yet approachable in a non-threatening way.
